What Is The Difference Between Snaking & Hydro Jetting?

Unlike snaking a drain, hydro jetting has the power to break up tough clogs AND remove materials from interior pipe walls. Plumbing snakes just puncture the clog and help break it apart. Hydro jetting offers a thorough

maintenance cleaning of the plumbing pipes to prevent future clogs and more expensive sewer repairs.



BIG JOB / BIG IMPACT

Our team recently completed a big job at the Culver's on Hamilton Dr in Sioux City. Culver's had a 1,500 gallon **Grease Trap Interceptor system**. We used a 60 ton crane and added an additional 3,000 gallon concrete tank (over 40,000 pounds!) to create a **Grease Trap Interceptor system with a total capacity of 4,500 gallons!**



A Grease Trap Interceptor system catches grease and other harmful particulates. The system strains and separates the grease and other food particles. The lighter particulates float to the top of one compartment of the tank while the water flows through system and eventually goes out to the sewer line, leaving behind the particulates and grease to be manually pumped out later.

The system positively impacts our environment by keeping the sewer lines clean from grease build-up.

MJ MINOR'S RECIPE OF THE MONTH

The Pioneer Woman's Carmel Apple Pie

This recipe is direct from The Pioneer Woman, Ree Drummond. Created with fresh fall apples and finished with sweet caramel, there was only one recipe we wanted to share with you this month!

Ingredients:

1 whole pie crust
6 c. (to 7 cups) peeled and sliced Granny Smith apples
Juice of 1/2 a fresh lemon
1/2 c. sugar
4 tbsp. flour
1/4 tsp. salt
1/2 c. flour
1 1/2 stick butter
1 c. brown sugar
1/2 c. quick oats
1/4 tsp. salt
1/2 c. pecans, chopped
1/2 jar (or more) caramel topping



Directions:

1. In a bowl, mix peeled apples, lemon juice, sugar, flour and ¼ teaspoon salt. Set aside. For crumb topping, cut the butter into the flour with a pastry cutter, then add in brown sugar, oats, and ¼ teaspoon salt.
2. Add apples to prepared pie shell and top with crumb topping. Cover crust edges with aluminum foil and bake in a 375* oven for 25 minutes. Remove foil from crust and place back into the oven for another 30 minutes. Chop pecans, and when five minutes remain, sprinkle them over the pie. Finish baking.
3. Remove the pie from the oven and pour ½ jar of caramel topping over the top. Allow to cool before serving.
